7. Are there any special circumstances that should be taken into account such as academic challenges faced, the student's socio-economic background, or any other obstacle that they have had to overcome in order to achieve success?

The content of your letter will remain confidential to the student. Thus, please answer freely with personal comments about the student and include any other pertinent information not listed above. Once completed, please return the letter to us in the included self-sealing envelope.
